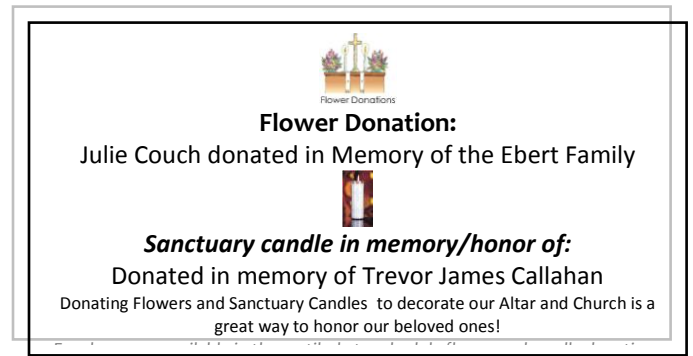
Prayer for Priests by St. Therese de Lisieux
