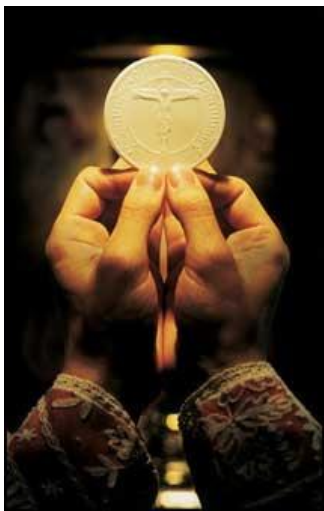
Christmas Crafters Wanted!
