Safe Environment Training will be held on September 18, 2019 in the parish hall at 6:30 PM. This training is required for all parishioners who work or plan to work with children in the parish. The training is designed to give adults the capacity to recognize child abuse and neglect.

If your training is more than 5 years old, it is time for to recertify by attending the training session. Thus, if your last training session was in 2015 or before, you must attend if you plan to work with children this year. In addition, if you went through a safe environment training or one different than the one given by the diocese, it will not be recognized as valid.
