Greetings. You must have already heard and read the new **Requirements for the Use of Face Coverings and Masks** from the NC Dept of HHS (link is below).

Starting last week, we have set in place a procedure to accommodate different levels of safety and observance of social distancing. We limited the seating capacity to 30 inside the church in order to maintain safety between/among attendees. We made the parish hall a sacred space for parishioners who prefers to wear mask/ face covering throughout the celebration of the mass.

So just like last weekend, our masses are:

5:00 PM - seating capacity - those who have signed up few weeks ago. There are chairs spread around the church for those who have not signed up.

8:30 Mass - also seating capacity and overflow will proceed to the parish hall/with the distribution of Holy Communion. The parish hall is wear a mask all the time and no singing.

The same procedure follows for the 11:00 AM Spanish mass. Please read the link below, if you haven't. Let us be charitable to one another, treat each other with respect, and we are in this together in making sure that we get through this safely and healthy.
