

FINANCE COUNCIL

The Finance Council meets quarterly to review the status of the performance (revenue and expenses) versus the projected/forecast Budget.

The Finance Council acts as a “sounding board” for the Pastor, on major projects (over \$1000) and assumes a major role in guiding any fundraising that is requested by the Parish Council.

The Parish Council reviews the Annual Budget which is submitted to the Raleigh Diocese by June 30th, each year.

The Budget is calculated to support the Parish Council and the Finance Chair sits as an appointed member of the Parish Council to assure timely communication as well as sufficient cash flow to cover emergencies, and newly appointed Pastor, etc.

Locally, we ask that anyone wishing to join the Council, start by becoming a Counter, and then ask to be considered for the Finance Council, as members of the Finance Council are required to be Observers of the weekly counting Team in action.

There are four members of the Finance Council serving different tenures. Members are appointed, and serve at the pleasure of the Pastor and Finance Chair. We have a two year, three year, and four year member in accordance with Diocesan policy.
